The project will be realised through two activities:

Youth Exchange I which will take place between 30.07 - 06.08. 2017 in Weimar, Germany

Youth Exchange II which will take place between 02.09 - 09.09.2017 in Tuzla, Bosnia and Herzegovina

This call is open for participants who are residents of Germany, Kosovo and Bosnia and Herzegovina.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Discrimination, devaluing "the Other" - someone who is different, has throughout history led to grave violations of human rights and crimes against humanity. Despite that, we still have discriminating practices targeting minorities and often vulnerable groups all around the world. Through this project young people from Germany, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Kosovo will address the topic of discrimination of LGBTI persons, addressing such discriminatory practices through the historic lens and comparing to present situation. Along with that, they will highlight activist movements which resisted discrimination and fought for equality. A specific geographical focus will be put on Germany, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Kosovo. The final product will be presented in the form of digital encyclopaedia of (anti)discrimination which will be accessible online.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Young people aged between 16 and 22, coming from Kosovo, Germany and Bosnia and Herzegovina. All workshops will be realised in the English language, therefore participants should have solid language skills. We are looking for 6 participants from Kosovo (plus 1 group leader), 8 participants from Bosnia and Herzegovina (plus 2 group leaders) and 6 participants from Germany (plus 1 group leader).

VENUES

The first Youth Exchange will take place in Weimar, Germany. Weimar is well known for its cultural and historical heritage. In its rich cultural and architectural heritage Weimar has three entries in UNESCO's World Heritage List. Therefore, in addition to interesting and moving workshops, you will have an opportunity to explore Weimar and walk the streets many famous artists have walked before (Johann Wolfgang von Goethe, Friedrich Schiller, Franz Listz). Also, you will have an opportunity to try varieties of local food such as the well known Thuringian Bratwurst.

The project will take place in the facilities of the European Youth Education and Meeting Centre in Weimar. The facilities include:

- 134 beds in single, two and three-bed rooms with shower and toilet
- 15 well equipped seminar rooms

The second Youth Exchange will take place in Tuzla, Bosnia and Herzegovina. Tuzla is the third largest city in B&H. Name of the city is derived from the Turkish word Tuz, meaning salt, and Tuzla is well-known for its salt mines and salt lakes. Tuzla is the only city in Europe that has a salt lake at its centre. In Tuzla, you will have an opportunity to try traditional Bosnian food and sweets.

COSTS

Accommodation and food will be provided by the organisers for the whole duration of the exchange. Travel costs will be covered based on the country you are coming from;

Participants travelling from Kosovo to Germany - 260,00 EURO

Participants travelling from Bosnia and Herzegovina to Germany - 260,00 EURO

Participants travelling from Kosovo to Bosnia - 104,00 EURO

Participants travelling from Germany to Bosnia and Herzegovina- 260,00 EURO

Unfortunately, we are not able to refund travel costs for local participants.
